

Competition Data Processing Policy

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1?Introduction

This Competition Data Processing Policy explains how personal and competition-related data is processed during the organization, administration, and completion of sporting events managed through the **HDH-IAA Competition Management Platform**.

This Policy supplements, and should be read together with, the Platform's:

- Privacy Policy;
- Terms of Service;
- Parent and Legal Guardian Consent Policy.

Where those documents already regulate a subject, they shall prevail unless this Policy expressly provides competition-specific provisions.

2?Purpose

The purpose of this Policy is to define:

- how competition data is processed;
 - which organizations may access competition data;
 - responsibilities of Competition Organizers and Federations;
 - publication of sporting results;
 - retention of official sporting records;
 - access to competition information by authorized officials.
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3?Scope

This Policy applies to all competitions administered through the Platform, including:

- local competitions;
- national championships;
- international competitions;
- qualification events;
- ranking competitions;
- leagues;

- team events;
 - youth competitions;
 - training events where participant registration is required.
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4? Roles and Responsibilities

For each competition, one or more organizations may participate in the processing of personal data.

Platform Operator

The Platform Operator provides and maintains the technical infrastructure used to process competition information.

Competition Organizer

The Competition Organizer determines:

- competition rules;
- eligibility requirements;
- participant acceptance;
- event scheduling;
- scoring procedures;
- publication of official results.

The Organizer acts as an independent Data Controller or Joint Controller where required by applicable law.

Federation

Where applicable, the Federation may process competition data for:

- athlete licensing;
 - rankings;
 - championship qualification;
 - disciplinary proceedings;
 - official sporting records.
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5? Competition Data

Competition-related data may include:

- registration information;
- participant identification;

- assigned competition category;
- shooting groups or heats;
- lane or target assignments;
- schedules;
- attendance;
- equipment class;
- inspection status;
- qualification scores;
- elimination scores;
- final rankings;
- medals and awards;
- team results;
- official decisions;
- appeals;
- disciplinary actions.

Only information necessary for the administration of the competition shall be processed.

6.2 Access to Competition Information

Access to competition information is granted according to the User's role.

Participants

Participants may access information relating to their own registrations, schedules, payments, and results.

Parents and Legal Guardians

Parents and Legal Guardians may access the competition information of linked Minor participants.

Competition Organizers

Competition Organizers may access information necessary for organizing their competitions.

Judges and Officials

Authorized officials may access participant information necessary to perform judging, scoring, inspection, and competition administration.

Federation Representatives

Federation representatives may access competition information where required for the administration of official sporting activities.

Platform access is governed by role-based permissions and the principle of least privilege.

7.2 Publication of Competition Information

The Platform may publish official competition information including:

- start lists;
- schedules;
- target assignments;
- participant names;
- clubs;
- countries;
- rankings;
- scores;
- official results;
- medals;
- championship standings.

Publication is considered necessary for the transparent administration of sporting competitions and the preservation of official sporting records.

8.2 Official Sporting Records

Competition results generated through the Platform constitute official sporting records.

Official sporting records may be retained indefinitely where necessary to preserve:

- competition history;
- championship records;
- rankings;
- statistical records;
- historical archives.

Corrections may only be made by authorized Competition Organizers or Federations in accordance with applicable sporting regulations.

9.2 Live Scoring and Public Display

Where live scoring is used, competition information may be displayed in real time through:

- electronic scoreboards;
- public displays;
- livestream overlays;
- official competition websites;
- authorized mobile applications.

Displayed information shall be limited to what is reasonably necessary for the administration and public presentation of the competition.

10 Photographs and Media

Competition Organizers may publish photographs, videos, livestreams, interviews, and other media relating to competitions.

Such media may include participants, officials, coaches, and award ceremonies.

The processing of personal data contained within such media shall be carried out in accordance with applicable law and the Platform's Privacy Policy.

11 International Competitions

Where competitions involve participants from multiple countries, competition data may be shared with authorized national or international Federations as necessary to:

- verify eligibility;
- calculate rankings;
- determine championship qualification;
- administer official sporting records;
- comply with applicable sporting regulations.

Any international transfer of personal data shall be carried out in accordance with the Privacy Policy and applicable data protection legislation.

12 Data Accuracy

Competition Organizers are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of:

- participant lists;
- competition schedules;
- scores;
- rankings;

- official results.

Participants are responsible for promptly notifying the Organizer of any inaccuracies concerning their own registration information.

13?Competition Disputes

Disputes relating to:

- scores;
- rankings;
- judging;
- eligibility;
- equipment inspections;
- disciplinary decisions;

shall be resolved exclusively under the procedures established by the Competition Organizer or the relevant Federation.

The Platform Operator is not responsible for adjudicating sporting disputes.

14?Security o?Competition Data

Competition data is protected using the technical and organizational measures described in the Privacy Policy.

Additional measures include:

- role-based access control;
- audit logging of administrative actions;
- secure communication between authorized users;
- controlled publication of official results;
- controlled modification of competition records.

Only authorized personnel may modify official competition information.
